School Reopening and Environmental Initiatives:

The academic year at Aksharamuttom Pallikoodam commenced in early June with a joyous admission festival. After overcoming significant challenges, the children returned to school with immense happiness. Regular meetings were held on Mondays and Wednesdays to discuss and finalize plans for class conduct and school operations. These meetings were consistently attended by School Director Rev. Fr. Thomas P. Mukalil, Principal T. Kuriacose, and Vice Chairperson Jessy Ma'am. On June 5th, in celebration of World Environment Day, a sandalwood tree was planted as a reminder of our duty to protect nature. Additionally, on June 26th, an online dance program was organized, which the children thoroughly enjoyed and appreciated.

Continuing the 'അമ്മയാണക്ഷരം' program, online classes were provided for students from grades 3 to 7 to enhance their proficiency in the mother tongue. This initiative, announced during the previous school anniversary, has been highly effective. To further broaden the student's knowledge base, a G.K. lab was established, offering various resources and activities aimed at improving general knowledge.



Tour Program and Evaluations:

A tour program took place on September 30th, allowing students and parents to explore Kuttikkanam, Peermedu, and Parunthumpara. The term evaluation occurred from August 2nd to 23rd. To combat substance abuse among children, an online class by the Kerala Government Excise Department was held, benefiting parents. Parent-teacher meetings to discuss student progress were conducted on September 28th. The Onam celebration, Uthradam Sadhya, was celebrated online. Additionally, the Mobile Health Team Screening (RBSK) ensured students' health, in collaboration with the health department.





Vidyarambham and Various Activities:

In October, the Vidyarambham ceremony was held with prayers, marking the beginning of formal education for the youngest students. This auspicious event was conducted in the school courtyard. Additionally, students were given an assignment to understand the importance of the Avocado plant, with the best submissions being recognized and celebrated. October 17th was observed as Hand Washing Day, emphasizing the importance of hygiene and cleanliness. To highlight the significance of various days and colors, a series of color day celebrations were organized, which were both educational and enjoyable for the students

On November 17th, a Cultural Meet was held, providing a platform for students to exhibit their talents in various cultural activities.
